Economy 7

Night kWh will be supplied for a total of 7 hours between 10pm and 8am (actual times set by the local network operator) and these will be charged off the Night kWh rate. All other kWh will be charged at the day kWh rate.

Economy 10

Economy kWh hours will be supplied for a total of 3 hours between 12pm and 4pm and for 7 hours between 7pm and 5am (actual times set by the local network operator – all times are GMT) and are charged off the Economy kWh rate. The Economy 10 tariff is currently not available to new customers acquisitions. For further details on tariff information, please call us free on 0800 096 9000[†].

Green Tariff

If you switch to our Green Tariff, we guarantee to source a supply of electricity – equal to your annual consumption – from environmentally friendly renewable sources. All we ask is that you pay a small premium for the Green Tariff – just 0.42p (inc VAT) extra for each kWh of electricity you use. For every penny you pay into the fund, EDF Energy will match it. This premium is not used directly to purchase from renewable sources but is instead placed in a fund where it will be invested in new, renewable electricity sources.

Eco20:20

Eco20:20 off peak rate will apply for a total of 10 hours between 9pm and 7am Monday to Friday and all weekend from 9pm Friday until 7am Monday (all times are GMT). Eco20:20 tariff is set to GMT times, this

means when the clocks change to British Summer Time, your off-peak times will be 10pm until 8am on weekdays.

Additional Charges and Discounts

1. An electricity Customer paying by monthly Direct Debit will receive a 6% discount off their energy charges, and is credited to their electricity bill on a pro-rated basis in-line with your bill frequency. This discount is calculated prior to any other discounts and VAT being applied.
2. A gas Customer paying by monthly Direct Debit will receive a 6% discount off their energy charges, on a pro-rated basis in-line with your bill frequency. This discount is calculated prior to any other discounts and VAT being applied.
3. A Dual Fuel Customer will receive a Dual Fuel discount of £8.40 (£8.00 excluding VAT) per annum, irrespective of their payment method. This is calculated daily and is credited to the customer's gas bills on a pro-rated basis in line with their billing frequency. Gas card customers are advised to regularly charge their cards to ensure they receive this discount.
