

## PLANNING CONSENT

EDF Energy Networks will carry out the work described in its quotation only if we are satisfied that any necessary planning permission and, where appropriate, listed building consent has been secured for the property to be used for the purpose for which the connection is required.

It is your obligation to:

- Ensure that you have any necessary permissions prior to EDF Energy Networks carrying out the work
- Provide EDF Energy Networks, on request, with copies of the planning permission, and listed building consent where it is required, which permits the development to be connected
- Contact your local planning authority, on request, to obtain written evidence of the following:
  - (i) that no planning permission or listed building consent is or was required for the construction and/or use of the building/development that is required to be connected; or
  - (ii) if any planning permission, or listed building consent, is or was required, that;
    - the building/development has been constructed in accordance with that permission and consent in all respects; and
    - the use of the building/development for which the connection to EDF Energy Networks electrical distribution system is required, complies with that permission; and
    - the permission or consent was not granted subject to any conditions which bind EDF Energy Networks.

If you are unsure whether you have the necessary permissions for the connection we recommend that you contact your local planning authority and request the information listed above.

**If you do not have planning permission, or the benefit deemed planning permission under the Town and Country planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, EDF Energy Networks will not be able to make the connection for you.**

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
