How to find your prices

- The Electricity prices are indicated in the top table. To find which ones apply to you, first look in the column down the left which shows the area where you live. Once you've found that, look along the table to see which unit rates apply in your area.
- The Gas prices are indicated in the bottom table. The prices are the same for all areas.
- The Fixed Price 2015 rates are shown both including and excluding VAT, as well as split by the different bands. The bands are explained within the notes section on the reverse of this form.

NOTES:**ADDITIONAL CHARGES AND DISCOUNTS**

- A. As defined in the full Fixed Price 2015 rules, a £100 early termination fee will be applied to your electricity account should you change your electricity tariff before 30 June 2011; a £75 early termination fee will be applied to your electricity account should you change your electricity tariff before 30 June 2012; and a £50 early termination fee will be applied to your electricity account should you change your electricity tariff before 30 June 2013.
- B. As defined in the full Fixed Price 2015 rules, a £100 early termination fee will be applied to your gas account should you change your gas tariff before 30 June 2011; a £75 early termination fee will be applied to your gas account should you change your gas tariff before 30 June 2012; and a £50 early termination fee will be applied to your gas account should you change your gas tariff before 30 June 2013.
1. An electricity customer paying by monthly Direct Debit will receive a 6% discount off their energy charges and is credited to their electricity bill quarterly. This discount is calculated prior to any other discounts and VAT being applied.
 2. A gas customer paying by monthly Direct Debit will receive a 6% discount off their energy charges and is credited to their gas bill quarterly. This discount is calculated prior to any other discounts and VAT being applied.
 3. A Dual Fuel Customer will receive a Dual Fuel discount of £8.40 (£8.00 excluding VAT), irrespective of their payment method. This is calculated daily and is credited to your gas bill/card quarterly.
 4. The gas charges stated in this leaflet may vary if your premises are not directly connected to the pipelines of the gas distribution networks of National Grid Gas, Scotia Gas Networks (Scotland Gas Networks and Southern Gas Networks), Northern Gas Networks and Wales & West Utilities. In these circumstances, your gas bill will be subject to an additional charge of 11.50p per day (10.95p exc VAT). If you have any queries please call us free on 0800 096 9000[†].
 5. An Electricity Bill Saver discount is available to customers in the Seeboard, SWEB and London regions with no mains gas supply and an active electricity account. The amount of £8.40 (including VAT) per year will be paid at the amount of £2.10 (including VAT) per quarter for customers supplied by EDF Energy as a credit to electricity quarterly bills.

*** Electricity Standard**

Fixed Price 2015 is only available to customers with a Standard Credit meter. Where applicable, the Band A rate will apply to a block of 900 kWh each year. This will be applied on a pro rata basis for each day covered by the relevant bill and rounded to the nearest whole kWh e.g. for an electricity bill covering 90 days the first 222 kWh used in that billing period would be charged at the Band A rate all other day kWh will be charged at the Band B rate[†].

**** Gas**

Fixed Price 2015 is only available to customers with a Standard Credit meter. The Band A rate will apply to a block of 2680 kWh each year. This will be applied on a pro rata basis for each day covered by the relevant bill and rounded to the nearest whole kWh e.g. for a bill covering 90 days the first 661 kWh used in that billing period would be charged at the Band A rate all other day kWh will be charged at the Band B rate[†].

[†] Note these gas prices only apply when taken as part of a Dual Fuel supply under this scheme.

^v Where there are any changes to these prices and/or tariff structures during a billing period, charges and/or tariff structures will be pro rated for the number of days up to the price change date. The new charges will apply pro rata for the remaining bill period. Estimated data may be used in accordance with rule 5 of your terms.

- The charges stated on this tariff sheet are dependant upon the suitability of the existing metering at your premises
- The charges stated in this leaflet are only available for the supply of gas and electricity to continuously occupied premises used exclusively or mainly for domestic purposes within the areas defined above
- The Dual Fuel and monthly Direct Debit discounts are only applicable to tariffs within this leaflet and are subject to you having a concurrent supply of gas and electricity under an EDF Energy Domestic Supply Contract
- You will not receive the discount for any period where there is no such concurrent supply (e.g. where supply of one fuel has not commenced or the supply of one fuel ends but the supply of the other fuel continues)

Where prices are shown including VAT, the VAT will be charged at 5%. Note that some including VAT prices have been naturally rounded.

All prices are correct at time of publication (February 2010) although are subject to change. These prices will be effective on your account once we have successfully registered you (please refer to rule 2 of the terms).
