

## LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 05 OF 2020

### Hinkley Point C Jetty – Repair and Maintenance Works

Mariners are advised that from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> August to Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2020, the vessel “ALEC.D” will be operating within Hinkley Point C Harbour limits (see attached chart extract) and will be conducting essential jetty fender repairs in the area marked by the red circle. ‘ALEC.D’ may be contacted directly and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16 and 87.

Whilst conducting jetty repairs the vessel will be ‘restricted in her ability to manoeuvre’ and will display the lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (as amended).

Vessels within this area are requested to proceed with caution and maintain a **minimum safe distance of 2 cables**.
