

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 07 OF 2020

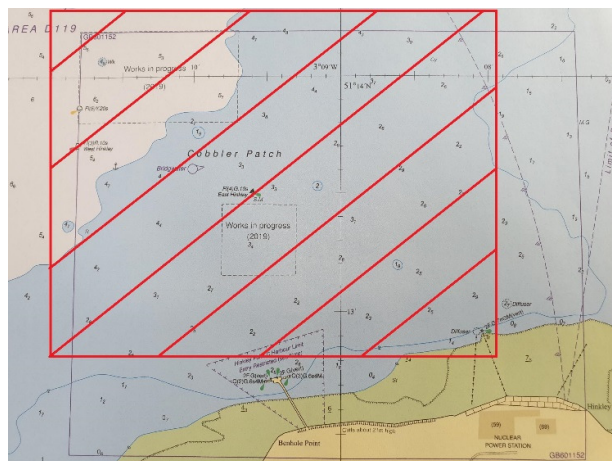
Hinkley Point C – UXO Survey Operations

Mariners are advised that from Friday 11th September 2020 the survey vessel “Proteus” will be operating within the approaches to Hinkley Point C Harbour Authority for a period of up to two months (see attached chart extract below of approximate operating area).

“Proteus” will be conducting hydrographic and UXO magnetometer survey operations, towing 4No. Magnetometers circa 3m above the seabed.

The vessel may be contacted directly and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16 and 87.

Whilst conducting survey operations this vessel will be ‘restricted in its ability to manoeuvre’ and will display the appropriate lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (as amended).

Vessels within this area are requested to proceed with caution and maintain a **safe distance well clear at all times**.
