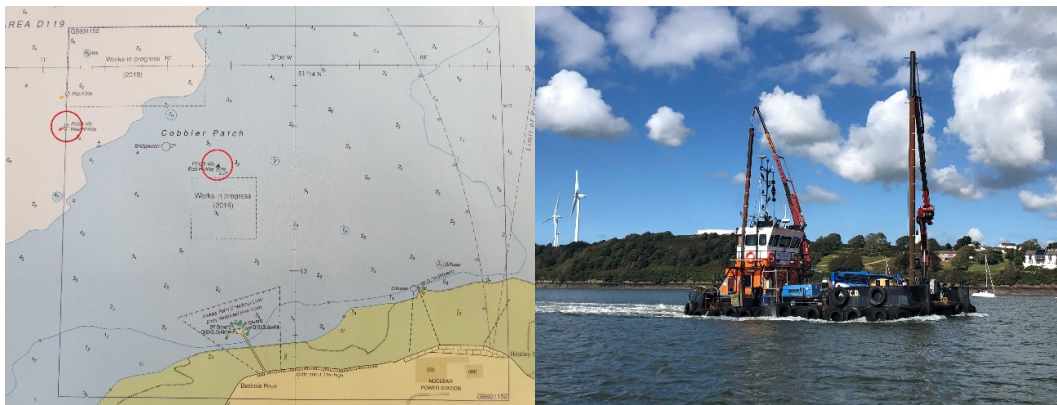
Mariners are advised that the following HPC lateral marks are scheduled to be temporarily removed on Thursday 18 March to allow the successful completion of UXO survey works:

Red Port Lateral Buoy 51° 13' .70N 003° 10' .80W

Green Starboard Lateral Buoy 51° 13' .50N 003° 09' .60W

The Alec D will be conducting these works between 0700-1030hrs LT. The vessel will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16.
