

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 11 OF 2021

Additional UXO Investigation & Clearance Works

15/04/2021

Mariners are advised that the Hinkley Point C Marine Works Principal Contractor is carrying out additional Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) Investigation & Clearance Works out to sea, in the area to the north of Hinkley Point C Harbour Authority (as shown on the chart extract below).



The vessel "HM Denham" will be conducting these works and will be supported by the vessel "Anchorman 5". Works are due to take place from the 15th April and estimated to last for approximately two weeks. The vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16 and 87.

Weighted surface marker buoys will be left in various locations within these areas for the duration of this campaign and whilst diving operations are in progress a 500m exclusion zone around the diving vessel "HM Denham" will be in force.

Vessels within this area are requested to proceed with caution and stay well clear.
