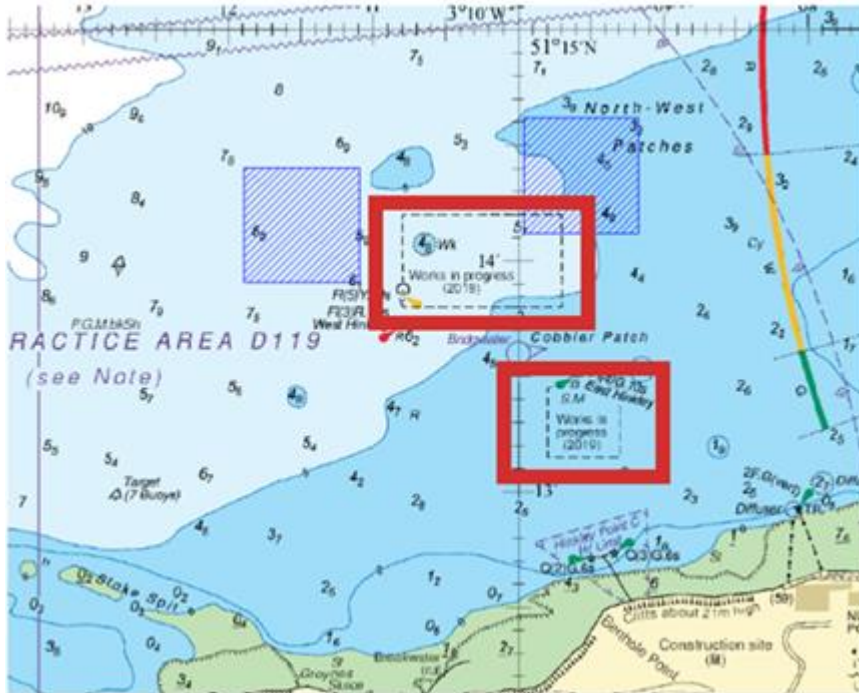


Chart extract of specific HPC dredging activity operating areas within the marine offshore/CDM area.

Works will commence in this area from **Thurs 5th August** to approximately **31st October**, with operations taking place day and night. Some vessels will be restricted in their ability to manoeuvre when operating.

Passing vessels are to proceed with caution and advised to stay well clear of the operating areas.
