EAST Hinkley and WEST Hinkley Lateral Mark Temporary Removal

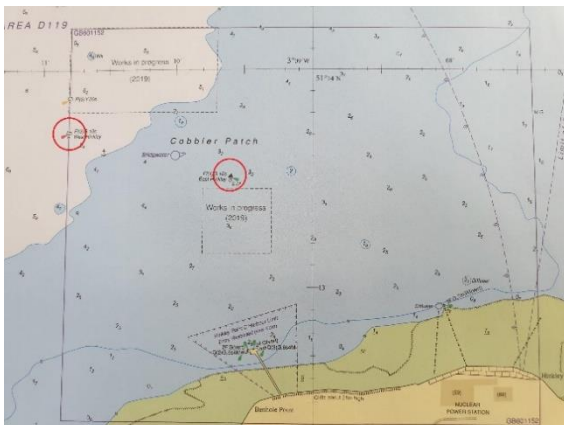

Mariners are advised that the following HPC lateral marks are scheduled to be temporarily removed on **Monday 9th August 2021** to allow for ongoing marine works. The previous scheduled removal (as per Local Notice to Mariners 22 of 2021) was unable to go ahead due to weather.

Red Port Lateral Buoy 51° 13' .70 N 003° 10' .80 W
Green Starboard Lateral Buoy 51° 13' .50 N 003° 09' .60 W

The Noordstroom will be conducting these works during daylight hours, between 0600 and 1900hrs LT. The vessel will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16.
