Hinkley Point C Marine Works Offshore Area Installation of Intake and Outfall Heads

Issued: 10/07/2022

Mariners are advised that from Monday 11th July Heavy Lift Vessels, 'Gulliver' and 'Rambiz', will commence installation of intake and outfall heads inside the marine works area highlighted below.

They will be supported by support vessels, 'Lingestroom', 'Voe Vanguard', 'UltraTug 3', 'Noordstroom', 'Brutus' and 'Carly', and Crew Transfer vessels, 'Commander P' and 'Channel Chieftain VI'. Survey Vessel 'Faraday' will be carrying out survey work.

Operations will take place during the day and night and are expected to last until the end of August 2022.
