

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 16 OF 2022

Hinkley Point C Marine Works Offshore Area Installation of Filter Layer (Rock material).

Issued: 24/08/2022

Mariners are advised that from Saturday 27th August to Thursday 3rd November a marine works campaign, involving the discharging of rock material from split hopper barges onto the seabed will commence, in various locations within the HPC Marine Works Offshore Area. This area as identified to mariners in the chart extract below, shown as the 'works in progress' area.

Marine operations will involve the towage of spilt hopper barges from Avonmouth and back, which will take place during the day and night. Survey and levelling works will also be undertaken by specific support vessels and levelling works will involve the use of eight-point anchor plan spreads.

Be advised that a series of underwater obstructions will continue to exist in this area.
