


Preparations for RPV installation



- At the end of August, the final set of columns for the Hatch Transfer System (HTS) were installed, completing the six columns needed for the system and bridge installation located on the Fuel Building.
- Construction has also commenced on the Outside Lifting System (OLS) with the base plates and counterweights already installed and the 40-metre-tall column in progress.

Preparations for RPV installation



Flamanville – start up process

- The 'first criticality' (first nuclear reaction) took place on Tuesday 03 September at 15:54 French time.
- An important milestone in the start-up operations of the plant.
- Currently at 0.2% of rated power, will gradually ramp up to 25%.
- At that point will be connected to the national grid for the first time and generate electricity (expected by late Autumn).




Transport and Logistics



- An expanding requirement for covered storage space for pipework and cabling before installation at HPC.
- MEH Alliance considering the use of further off-site warehouse space at Junction 24.
- Potential to phase refurbishment work across the site and make use of the excellent location close to existing HPC infrastructure.

Transport and Logistics – C182

- With surveys now complete, work to repair the C182 will be completed over the coming months with a start date confirmed soon.
- Exact scope and schedule for the works is yet to be fully confirmed
- Advanced warnings will be provided locally via our normal channels and Council travel updates.
- Finalisation of traffic management with County Highways.







Mitigations continue to limit impact




Current impact example – Reported Crime since 2021



ONR Report Q1-3 2024

In this period, routine inspections (including unannounced inspections) of the Hinkley Point C site covered the following:

- plant construction and/or commissioning;
- radiography
- quality assurance and records;
- organisational capability, including the function of the Internal Regulator;
- conventional (non-nuclear) health and safety, including life fire safety;
- security

ONR Report Q1-3 2024

ONR continues its engagement with the project via regular site inspections, visits and meetings at NNB GenCo (HPC) Ltd's offices and supplier locations across the following themes:

- design and safety case;
- organisational capability (including supply chain and quality);
- pre-operations;
- conventional health and safety and fire safety; and
- security.

These inspections, along with routine contact with other international regulatory bodies provide ONR with valuable intelligence on the progress NNB GenCo (HPC) Ltd is making developing its competence and capability to manage the design, procurement, and construction of HPC and will inform future permissioning decisions.

Permissioning

- RPV installation will be a major permissioning point, using primary powers.
- In advance of major permissioning points ONR will continue to apply flexible permissioning to allow the start of a number of other activities.
- ONR concluded flexible permissioning in relation to the commencement of early commissioning activities on Low Voltage switchboards.

Non-routine matters

- The investigations into the tragic fatality that occurred on site in November 2022 and the separate event at site that resulted in a worker sustaining injuries as a result of a rebar mesh wall falling continue.
- At this time, we are unable to provide further details about the ongoing investigations as these remain live inquiries.
- Dutyholders have complied with enforcement notices served under the fire safety reform order. These notices were served in relation to conventional health and safety matters and not nuclear related safety matters.



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
