

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 09 OF 2024

Hinkley Point C Marine Works Offshore Area – Rope Access Maintenance Works

Issued: 04/11/2024

Rope access maintenance works will be conducted on the guide frame structures located within the charted HPC marine works in progress area as detailed below. The support vessel “NRH Ariel” will be used for the personnel transfer of this team and will also provide safety cover for the duration of works on the structure. Personnel will transit daily to/from the CDM via the support vessel that will operate out of Cardiff Bay.

It is expected that these works will commence from the 5th of November (weather permitting) and continue for 7 days. Operations will take place in daylight hours only. Operations may be extended due to adverse weather causing delays.
