
Acoustic Receiver and Buoy Deployment

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday 25th and Wednesday 26th March 2025, weather permitting, an acoustic receiver array, marking receivers, and buoys will be deployed within the HPC Marine Works Offshore Area (see Admiralty Charts 1151, 1152, and the chart extract below). This array will remain in place until mid-September 2025.



Mariners are advised to remain well clear during deployment and recovery, and to avoid anchoring in the vicinity of the equipment once laid. **Mariners are requested to keep well clear of the marker buoys throughout the deployment period.**

The arrangement will consist of 200m lines of acoustic receivers weighted on the seabed, marked by red polyform net buoys, as below:
