


LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 03 OF 2025

Hinkley Point C Marine Works Offshore Area –

Issued 03/03/25

Six surface buoys will be deployed within the charted HPC marine works in progress area. Deployments will extend in a 200m line, with either end marked by a yellow A3 circular polyform surface buoys with four red A3 circular polyform buoys spaced between. The area for deployments is indicated below. The vessel “Alykat” will be used for the work and will be operating out of Minehead harbour.



It is expected that these works will take place on the 03 March (weather permitting). Operations will take place in daylight hours only, with deployment during the period around slack water between 1030 and 1630. These deployments will be in place for an expected period of 14 days but this could be extended due to adverse weather causing recovery delays
