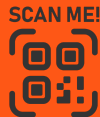
I am a civil engineer with over 20 years' experience in design and management of infrastructure projects within EU & UK. I have managed large international and geographically spread teams through complex delivery models.

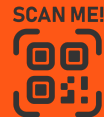

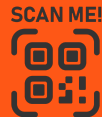

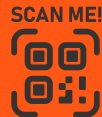
