Understanding HAROLD

HAROLD is a critical traffic management process that will be put into action during the construction of Hinkley Point C. It is a multi-agency process designed to provide alternative routes on local roads in case of a traffic incident on the C182. These alternative routes will vary depending on the location of the incident.

The main purpose of HAROLD is how to move People not Freight (HGVs)

Purpose of this guide


This booklet provides key steps to follow once HAROLD is implemented in an Incident Management Area on the C182 Hinkley Road to Cannington.

Note that incidents are not limited to Road Traffic Collision (RTC); any event causing a temporary road closure on the Main road (C182) from Cannington to the Hinkley Point Sites is covered.

Diversion routes

There are 5 possible diversion routes depending on the incident location.

Approved diversion road signs



Variable message signs (VMS)

Approved permanent diversionary signage will be located on all 5 agreed routes.

Two Mobile VMS signs will be activated and in operation immediately after a road closure on the C182 has been implemented :

➔ The 1st one will be positioned on the first roundabout at the main site entrance for vehicles leaving all 3 Hinkley sites.

➔ The 2nd will be positioned on the first A39 Cannington Roundabout, as approaching from Bridgwater.






Avon and Somerset Police will be positioning a two officer team at the Keenthorne junction with the A39. This is to help manage traffic, prevent vehicles from entering against the one-way system, and ensure the safe closure of the C182.



A one way system will apply at Fiddington

Incident route 1



From C182 East of Cockwood via Coultings to Keenthorne and the A39

Incident route 2



From C182 East of Cockwood via Coultings to C182 via Knaplock Lane

Incident route 3



From C182 East of Stogursey via Stringston to Holford and the A39

Incident route 4



From C182 South of Wick via Farrington Hill Lane and Cockwood to Claylands Corner

Incident route 5



From C182 South of Hinkley Point Gates via Wick to C182 Road to Hinkley, Wick
