³ Weekday kWh are those we supply from 7am to 7pm, Monday to Friday. Night kWh are those we supply from midnight to 7am. Evening and weekend kWh are those supplied from 7pm to midnight, Monday to Friday and from 7am to midnight on Saturday, Sunday and public holidays. For heating kWh, we supply eight hours each day. Six of these are supplied between 10pm and 8am and the other two are between 12pm and 5pm. We can decide to change the actual times of supply within these time bands and they can change each day.
