- You have provided EDF Energy with personal data (as that term is defined in the Data Protection Act 1998) in this form, and you hereby consent to EDF Energy using your personal data for the purposes of complying with, and giving effect to all relevant regulation and requirements of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority in relation to FITs,
- EDF Energy may use information within this form to check industry systems in accordance with the FITs scheme,
- You are not contracted under the Non-Fossil Fuel Obligation (NFFO) agreement,
- EDF Energy shall have no responsibility for any delays associated with the processing of the form, including but not limited to, delays associated with its delivery.
