Heysham Site Muster – Incident Stood Down

Early this morning at 12:21am, Heysham 1 power station declared a site incident following a leak of clean CO2 on station.

As you may be aware, we declare a site incident to allow us to sound our on-site alarms and muster and account for all staff who are working on site at this time. This is usual practice due to the size of plants and in line with our emergency arrangements.

This incident and muster was stood down around 4:20am this morning once the area had been cordoned off and the leak stopped.

To reassure you, at no point was there any danger to the public and a full investigation will now be carried out.
