

Powervault Fully Charged Prize Draw (the “Scheme”) Terms and Conditions (the “Rules”)



The Scheme is provided by EDF Energy Customers Ltd, a company registered in England & Wales with company number 2366852, having its registered address at 90 Whitfield Street London W1T 4EZ (the “Promoter”). Entry into the Scheme signifies acceptance of these Rules.

1. Scheme timeline

- 1.1 The Scheme will run from 09:00AM on 7th June 2019 (the “Opening Date”) to 16:00PM on 9th June 2019 (the “Closing Date”) inclusive.
- 1.2 All entries relating to the Scheme (the “Entries”) must be received by the Promoter through submission via electronic device available on the stand at the Fully Charged Live by no later than 15:59PM on the Closing Date. All Entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 1.3 **To enter the Scheme:**
 - a) To enter consumers will have to visit the Powervault stand at the Fully Charged Live show. Then answer the question “How much discount is available on Powervault at this year’s Fully Charged show?” by selecting the correct answer and submitting the online entry form on hand at the stand by the Closing Date.
 - b) There is no purchase necessary to enter the Scheme

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 The Scheme is only open to residents in the United Kingdom aged 18 years or over at the date of the Scheme, except:
 - a) employees of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies;
 - b) employees of agents or suppliers of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the Scheme or its administration; or
 - c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.
- 2.2 In entering the Scheme, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the Prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the Scheme. The Promoter will not accept Entries that are automatically generated by a computer, illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with, photocopies and not originals, or incomplete.
- 2.3 There is a limit of one Entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.

3. The Prize draw

- 3.1 Only participants who choose the correct answer to the Question and satisfy the eligibility criteria set out above will be entered into the Prize draw. The draw will take place at the Promoter’s stand at the Fully Charged Live show at 1630hrs on Sunday 9th June 2019. Winners will be selected at random from amongst the pool of participants entered into the Prize draw.
- 3.2 A name of the Prize winner will be displayed on the Promoter’s website: www.edfenergy.com/for-home/energywise/powervault-competition (the “Website”) from the Wednesday 19th June 2019 for a period of 30 days.

4. The Prize

- 4.1 There is one prize in total. The prize is not negotiable, transferable or exchangeable for a cash alternative.
- 4.2 The Prize will consist of one 4.1kWh Powervault 3, Smart solar battery, on EDF Energy’s grid services tariff delivered and installed at the winning entrant’s home (the “Prize”).
- 4.3 The Prize will be provided to the winner by EDF Energy Customers Ltd. Any other costs incurred in addition to those set out at Clause 4.2 above are the responsibility of the winner.
- 4.4 The Prize is subject to availability. The Promoter reserves the right, at its absolute discretion, to substitute the prize with an alternative prize.
- 4.5 The winner will be notified by the Promoter by Wednesday 19th of June 2019 or within 25 working days following Closing Date (the “Announcement Date”) by email or a telephone call and displaying their names on the Website/ EDF Energy social feeds.

5. Claiming the Prize

- 5.1 Powervault will contact the winner by email following the Announcement Date to confirm they have won the Prize and provide details on how and when installation can begin. The Promoter shall not be liable to the winner for, and Powervault solely shall be responsible for, liaising with the winner with regards to installing the Prize, facilitating the booking of the delivery and installation.
- 5.2 The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed the Prize within 60 days of the Announcement Date, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the Prize to an alternative eligible entrant selected from the valid Entries received.

6. Limitation of Liability

- 6.1 The Promoter does not accept responsibility for Entries that are lost/damaged or delayed, regardless of cause, including for example as a result of any postal or equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server or any computer hardware or software failure of any kind, nor will it accept proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of Entry into the Scheme.
- 6.2 Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

7. Data protection and publicity

- 7.3 You further agree to participate in any reasonable publicity required by the Promoter. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the Prize.

8. General

- 8.1 The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any Entry which does not fully comply with these Rules or if the entrant's conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the Scheme.
- 8.2 The Promoter may cancel this Scheme at any time, and/or may amend the terms of the Scheme. Any withdrawal of or changes to the Scheme shall be published on the Website.
- 8.3 If these Rules or any part of them should be determined to be illegal, invalid or otherwise unenforceable, then to the extent that they are so illegal, invalid or unenforceable, they shall in that state or country be treated as severed and deleted from these Rules and the remaining Rules shall survive and remain in full force and effect.
- 8.4 These terms and conditions shall be governed by the law of England and Wales, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
- 8.5 Please do not enter this Scheme if any of these provisions are unacceptable.
