What experience will I gain during the Renewable Energy Commercial programme?

During our three-year programme you'll develop your commercial understanding of the renewable energy industry and undertake assignments to support the provision of commercial, strategic and analytical advice to internal stakeholders.

What kind of placements will I complete?

Our programme is designed to help you develop a broad set of skills, with the opportunity to specialise towards the end of the programme when you'll start to think about a permanent role.

Following a week-long induction with graduates from all of our schemes in September, you'll head straight to your first placement.

In years 1 and 2, you'll complete placements in our Strategy and Analysis and our Development teams. You'll gain an understanding of the key aspects of project development, such as origination, project management and valuation, all of which is geared toward reaching investment decisions on wind, battery and solar assets.

Our **Strategy & Analysis** function is at the heart of what we do. The team continually look for ways the organisation can make efficiencies to ensure competitiveness in the market to allow for project bids to be successful. The strategy of the business is created over the short, medium and long-term to support financial investment decisions and to create market contracts such as corporate power purchase agreements with some big high street brands.

The **Development** function allows the business to realise its objectives. Driving forward ambitions created against the business strategy, the team is responsible for taking projects from concept through the development cycle to financial close and then acting as client throughout the construction phase.
