
First of all, I would like to take this opportunity to wish all of you a very happy and healthy 2018.

As ever, I believe it is important to keep you updated on any developments at Hunterston B Power Station.

At around 1100 on Friday 5 January one of the units came offline automatically due to an electrical fault in the reactor side of the plant. Following a full investigation of the cause and a short programme of maintenance the unit was returned to service just after 1400 on Sunday 7 January. There were no safety, health or environmental impacts arising from this event and since return to service the unit has been providing its forecast electrical output to the national grid.

Hunterston B power station has generated low carbon electricity since 1976 and in 2016 provided enough electricity for almost 2 million homes.
